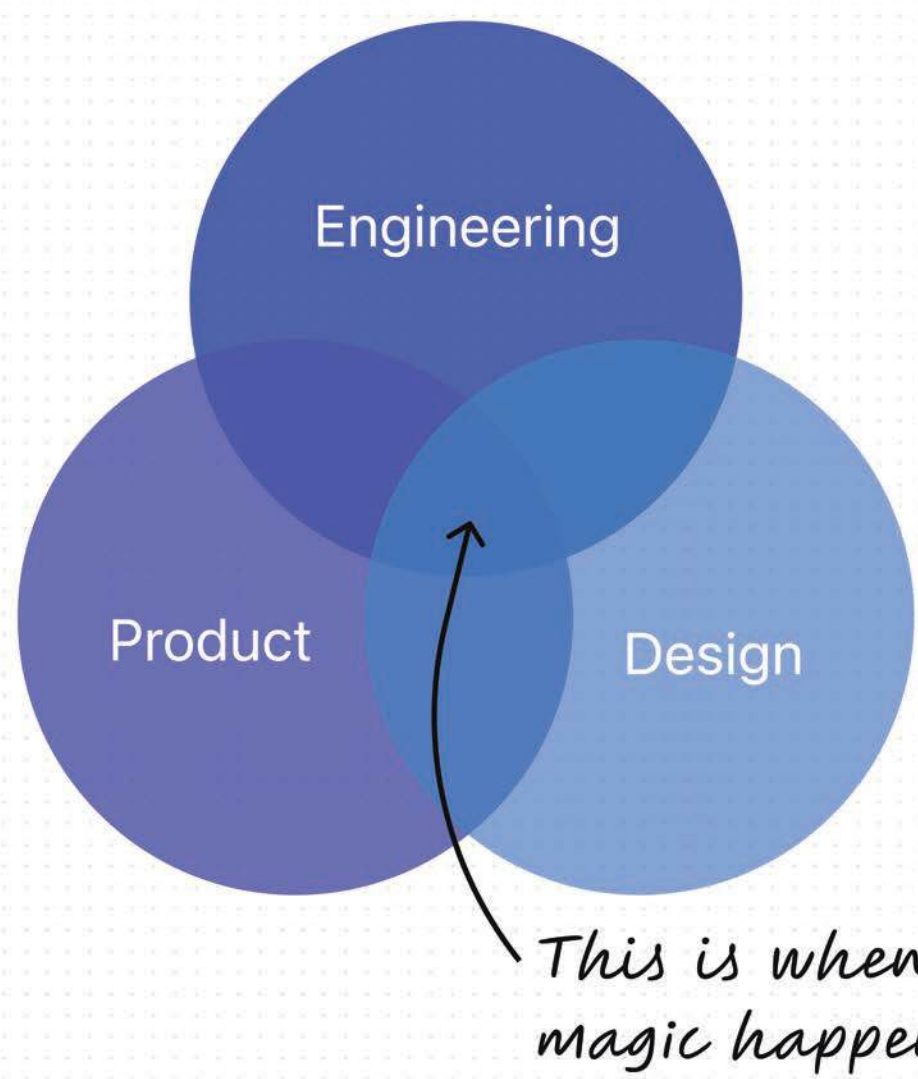

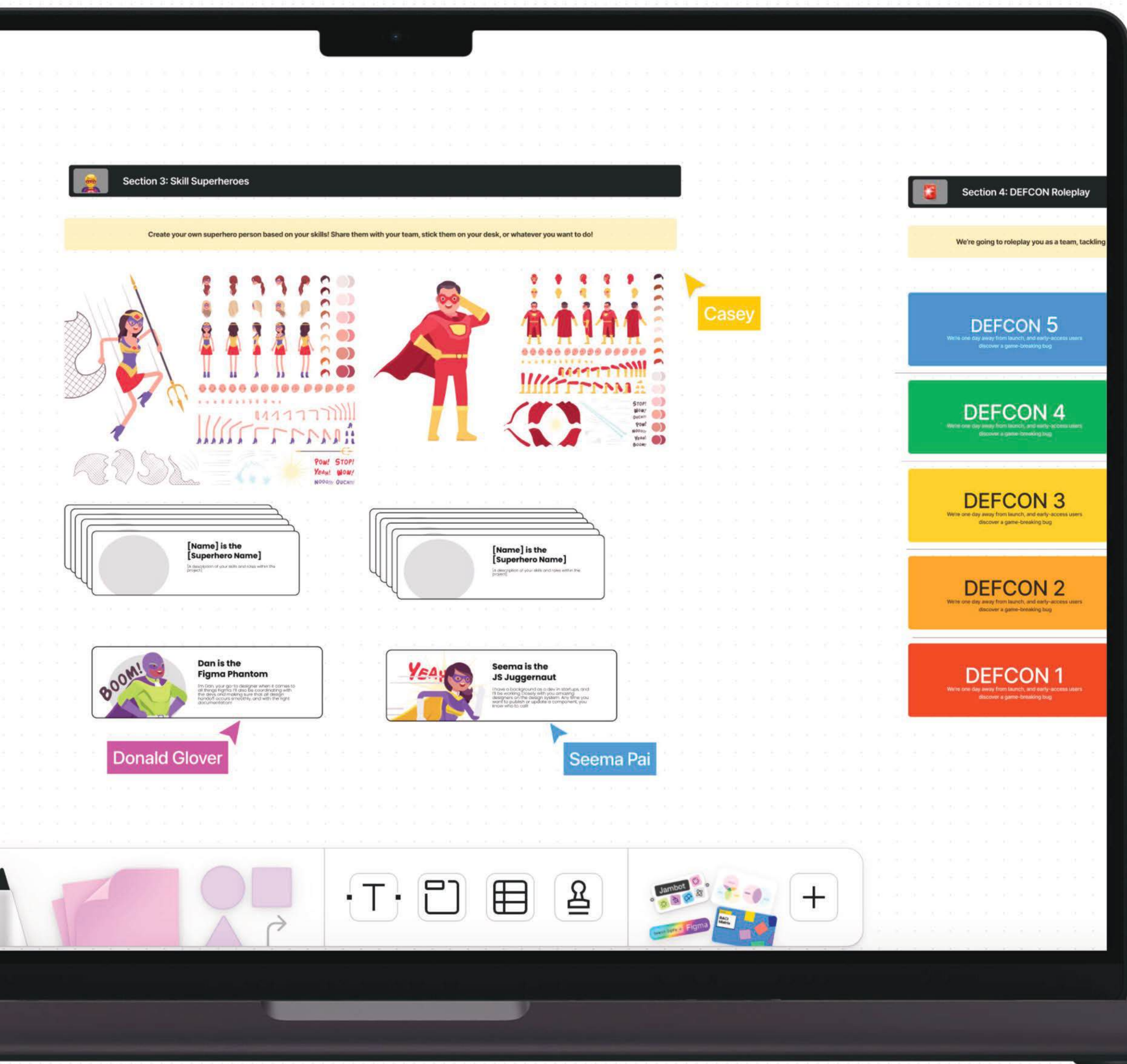
Streamlined collaboration speeds up product delivery, identifies issues early, and enhances team morale.

Kickoff Workshop

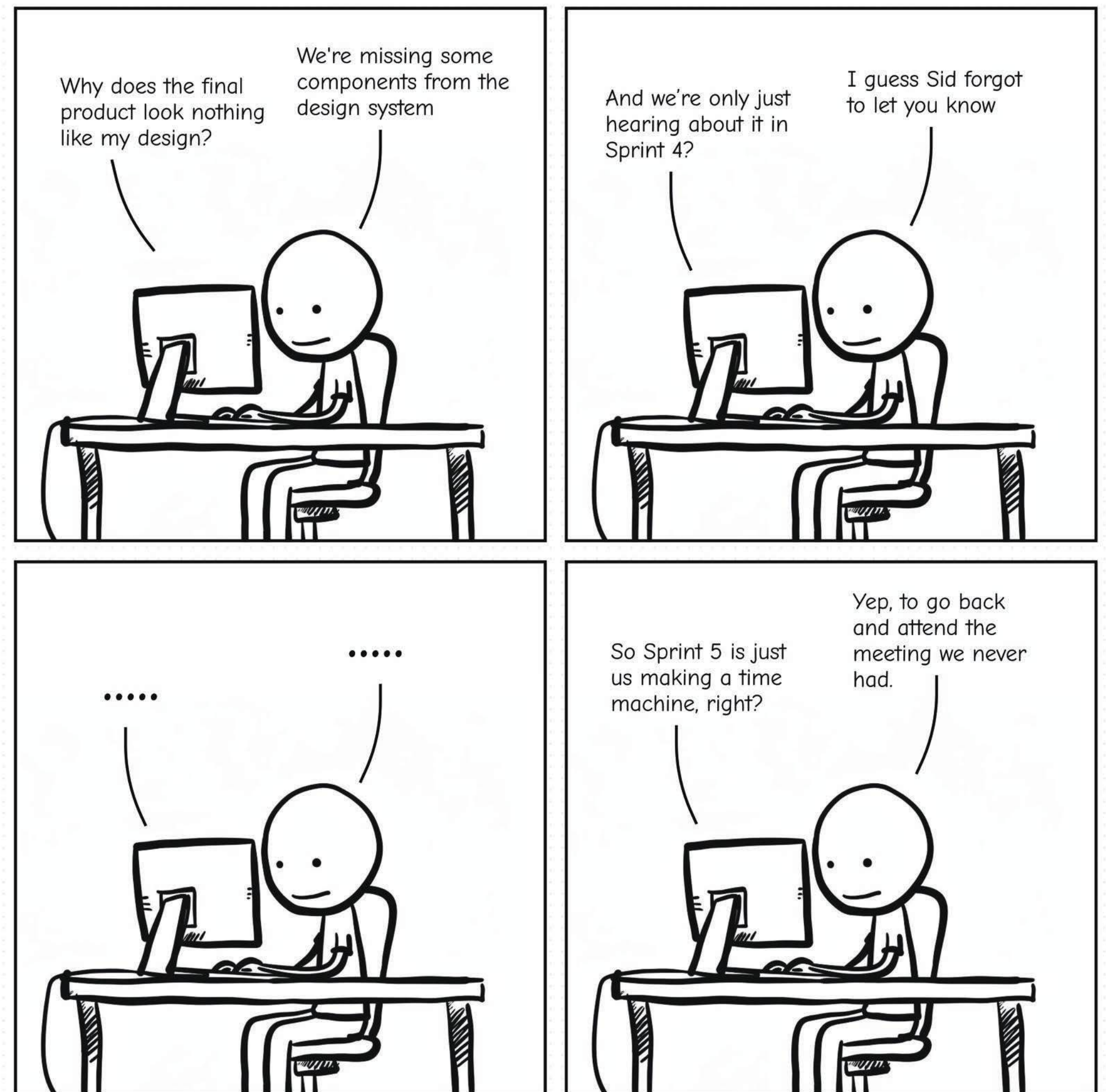
A FigJam kickoff workshop template designed for founders, team leads, or product managers to facilitate, ensuring active participation from every team member.



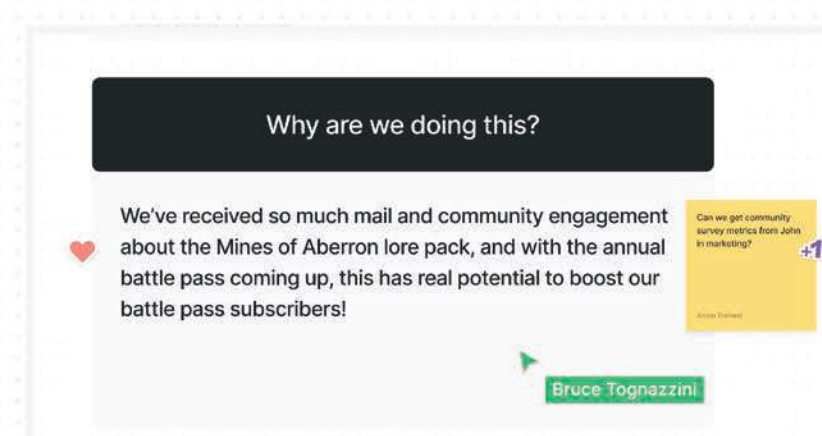
How might we establish working relationships and initial alignment among startup teams during project kickoff?

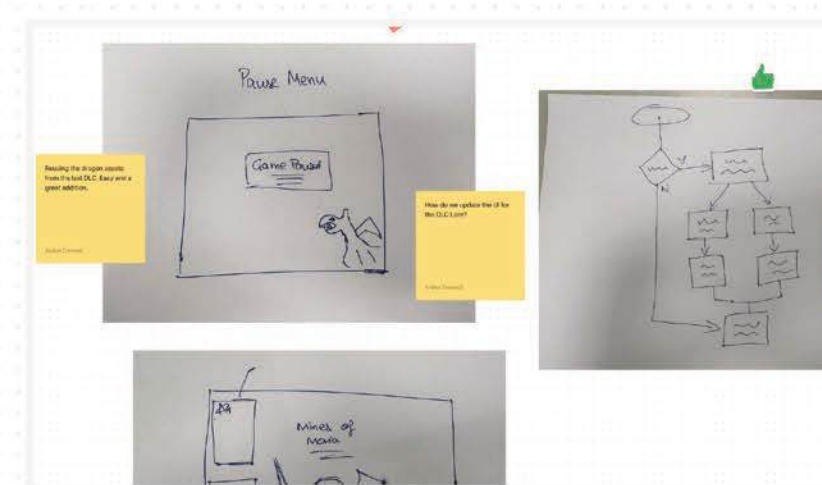
"The product launch was delayed by a week because our designers weren't aware that the design system hadn't been updated."



Through this workshop, team members should be able to understand each other's skills, get inspired by the project vision, and improve working relationships.



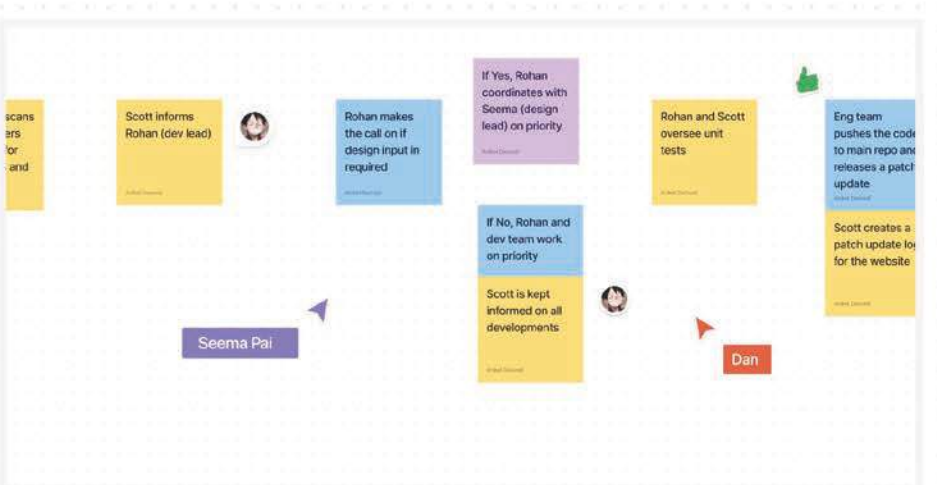
Project Vision
