Many first-time cat owners adopt **without fully understanding** the daily care needs their feline companions require. This lack of preparation makes them struggle with daily tasks.




Routine

After syncing their calendars during onboarding, users will receive personalized daily todo lists, guiding them through cat-care tasks from morning to evening.




Users perform tasks within a pet store to familiarize themselves with a variety of available pet products.
